Chicago *a cappella* is a creative enterprise devoted to furthering the art of singing together without instruments. An ensemble of nine singers founded by Jonathan Miller in 1993, Chicago *a cappella* presents an annual subscription series, creates studio recordings as well as live and broadcast-media musical content, and gives performances on tour and in special engagements. Long recognized for vocal virtuosity and innovative programming, the ensemble enjoys a reputation as a leader in the choral field.

Chicago *a cappella*'s Educational Outreach Program strives to promote and improve the life-long performance, understanding and appreciation of *a cappella* vocal music through programming, mentorship and collaboration with schools and community organizations in Chicago and beyond. This third annual Youth Choral Festival brings young Chicago-area singers together with Chicago *a cappella*'s professional singers and directors for a day of workshops, singing and performing at virtually no cost to the participating students, schools or organizations. This non-competitive festival culminates in a public concert featuring each of the participating choral groups singing alone and with Chicago *a cappella* as a Festival Choir.
